Shimane Arts Center Grand Toit 島根県芸術文化センター「グラントワ」 [Gurantowa]

This is a unique building that combines an art museum and theatre. Various exhibitions and performances are held throughout the year. Grand Toit means "large roof" in French and locally made Sekishu roof tiles spread out across the roof and walls of this grand building. It gives off different impressions depending on the time of day and the angle of the light, making it a work of art in its own right.

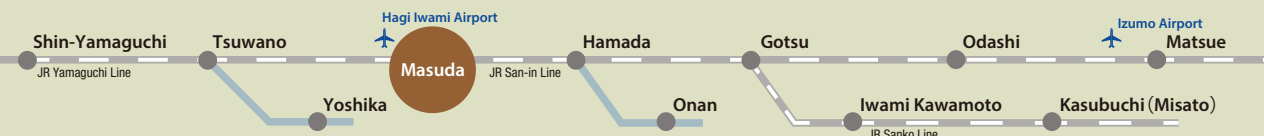
